

CVU Uniform Policies and Procedures

1. The Board of Directors (BOD) shall elect an individual responsible for managing the club uniform program. This person shall have the title 'Director of Uniforms'.
2. The Director of Uniforms (Director) shall have the responsibility and authority to negotiate club uniform contracts with uniform suppliers, recommend club uniform standards, establish club uniform policies and procedures, maintain a club uniform supply as required and provide assistance to club teams regarding all uniform issues.
3. Contracts with uniform manufacturers and distributors, negotiated by the Director, shall be approved by the BOD and signed by the club President and Uniform Director.
4. The club uniform selection process shall be accomplished by a 3 person committee led by the Director. Uniform recommendations shall be presented to the BOD for final approval,
5. Club uniform policies and procedures shall be presented to the BOD for approval.
6. Club uniform inventory shall be accounted for as a club asset by the club Treasurer. The Director shall, sell uniform inventory items as needed until supplies are exhausted,
7. All club teams shall wear the BOD approved club uniform for all league and USYSA tournament games.
8. All club teams shall purchase the BOD approved club uniform from the contracted uniform distributor.
 - a. Initial group team purchases shall be made through the Director.
 - b. Individual or team add-on purchases can be made through the CVU web site store or through the Director.
9. The minimum club uniform set is 1 home jersey, 1 away jersey, 1 short, and 1 pair of socks.
 - a. All other uniform or accessory items are optional.
 - b. Designation of home and away jersey is on a team-by-team basis as long as the uniform is part of the BOD approved uniform set and the home and away jerseys are different colors.
10. All club teams are guaranteed three seasons of wear of any BOD approved uniform set provided the uniforms are in good condition.

- a. It is not guaranteed that the manufacturer will continue to make the 'older' uniform set if the club changes to a 'new' style.
- b. Mixing and matching of 'new' and 'old' style uniforms is prohibited.

11. Coaches must dress in approved CVU wear.

- .a Coaches must wear approved CVU attire at all league, CalSouth, CSL and USYS games and tournaments.
- .b Coaches packets will be determined prior to the start of each season and made available during August.
- .c Use of the CVU logo on any non-authorized clothing or equipment is strictly prohibited.

12. Practices - Coaches and trainers are strongly encouraged to wear the approved practice t-shirts from either the coaches packets or the regular player practice t-shirts from CVU's uniform distributor.
